Encouraging Biblical Passages:

1 Samuel 18: 1-4; 1 Samuel 20; and 2 Samuel 1—The stories of the love, covenant, and bond between David and Jonathan

Psalm 139—God searches us, knows us, and created our inmost being

Matthew 5: 2-12—The Beatitudes, we are truly blessed

Mark 1: 29-31—The greatest commandment is love

Acts 8:36-40—The story of the Ethiopian Eunuch who was the first Gentile to be baptized and welcomed into the faith. Many understand the Ethiopian's identity as a eunuch to be a queer identity.

Acts 15—The Council at Jerusalem – A reminder that the LGBTQ community is not the only community that church leaders have debated over whether or not they should be included, and that in ancient times and today leaders have landed on the side of inclusion and welcome.

Romans 8:38-39—Nothing can separate us from the love of God

John 4: 1–42—Jesus talks to the Samaritan woman at the well, breaking cultural norms due to his love of all

John 15: 9-17—We are Jesus friends, whom He loves

John 16: 12-15—The Spirit and God are still speaking

Romans 13: 8-10—The commandments can be summed up in "Love your neighbor"

Galatians 3: 26 – 29—We are all children of God

Ephesians 2:10 -22 —We are God's handiwork, built together and created in Christ to do good works.

Ephesians 3:14-19—We are rooted and established in love, filled with the fullness of God **Colossians 1:14**—We are redeemed and forgiven

1 John 4: 7-12—God is love; perfect love drives out fear; No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God lives in us, and his love is perfected in us.
